



CLEMATIS VINES have sensational blooms in a range of gorgeous colors. Trained on arbors, walls, light posts, or fences, they grow 6-12' high, and take 2-3 years to become fully established. Clematis prefer even moisture, roots kept cool and shaded (use a light mulch or plant shallow rooted perennials over them), and lots of sunshine. Clematis contribute to any landscape with their graceful habits and splendid blooms.
