



FLOWERING VINES complement many different landscapes and gardens. They enhance perennial borders, can climb happily on arbors and fences, work to hide unsightly views and provide privacy screening. Long blooming ornamental flowering vines are often attractive to hummingbirds, even providing nesting sites. Some vines enhance the beauty of trees and flowering shrubs by twining through branches in an attractive way.
