



HARDY FERNS thrive in the cool shade garden during our hot humid summers with their graceful sizes and shapes. Evergreen or deciduous ferns (deciduous fronds die back in winter to re-emerge in spring) range from 1-5' in height, and may be delicate and lacy, or broad and upright. Carefree ferns combine well with many other shade-loving perennials such as Hostas, Pulmonarias, and Tiarellas.
