From white to all shades of blue, purple, and violet, Salvias are easy care, not fussy about soil, thrive in full hot sun with good drainage, are deer-resistant, and will often re-bloom when weather cools if cut back after blooming.

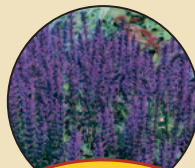
