To safely reduce indoor fly infestations...

• **Stop flies before they get into your house.**

Tend and maintain compost, manure and animal areas.

Use barriers such as screens and doors.

Place two or three bait or lure traps about 50 yards away from your house, if possible.

• **When possible, use low-impact methods to eliminate flies indoors.**

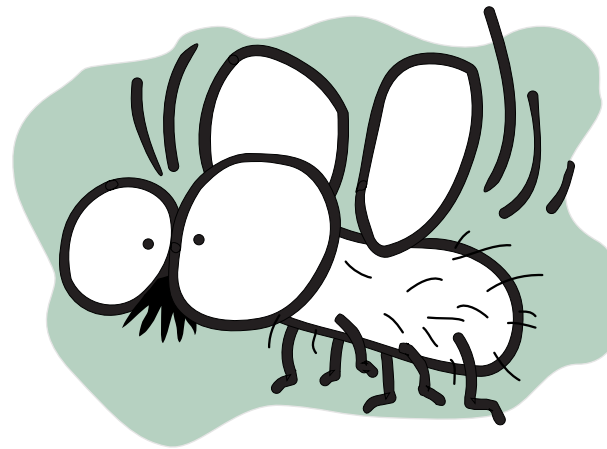
Flyswatters

Indoor Sprays ►

Never use outdoor insect sprays inside houses.

If the label reads 'Pyrethroid' compounds, do not use it inside.



When indoors, use sprays intended for indoors.

Indoor spray labels should say 'For flies and insects' and list natural pyrethrins (derived from chrysanthemums) as an ingredient.
